Greenware Deadline: Monday, 3/2

Work should be placed on the greenware carts by this date to be bisque fired for your last class. This deadline is set so your work can be glazed during your last class. **Any work placed on the carts after this deadline is not guaranteed to be fired by the last week of classes.**

Bisque and Glaze Firing Schedules

Kilns are fired regularly throughout the term based on the availability of work to be loaded. Bisque kilns are fired multiple times weekly up to the greenware deadline (glaze firings take priority once the greenware deadline has passed). Glaze kilns are loaded and fired once enough work is available to fill a kiln (for both gas and electric), and a gas kiln firing schedule is located in the glazeroom. Once work has been fired, it is ready for pick up in the fired workroom located outside of the tech office on the 2nd floor. The turnaround time for work to be fired is approximately two weeks.

****Please pick up items as soon as they are found and do not store work in the fired work room.***

Last Open Studio Day for Winter Term: 3/16

The school will be closed with no studio access after the last day of the term. If you are *NOT returning for Spring Term*, please clear out your cubby by 3/16. Any items left in cubbies after this date will be discarded or donated to the studio.

Pick Up Dates for Finished Work & Two-Week Pick Up Deadline:

Winter term pick up dates will be determined after the end of the term. It takes approximately 10-14 days after the last day of the term to fire all remaining work.

The studio will email students once all the work from the term has been fired and will provide specific dates and times available for pick up, along with a two-week pick-up deadline. After the pick up deadline has passed, any remaining work will be recycled, discarded, or donated.
